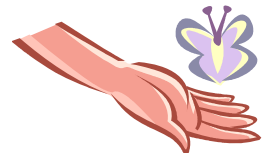

Just wishing that they could live.

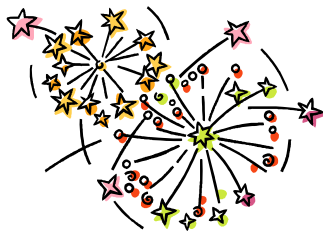
We hold on to the best,

Amend to Family Medical Leave Act of 1993 to Include the Death of a Child

It is my opinion that the death of a child is the worst experience that anyone can endure. However, many employers only allow 2-3 days of bereavement leave. Employees are expected to use their available vacation time after the 2-3 days of bereavement leave have been expended. If the employee exhausts both of these benefits and still requires additional time off the employer has grounds to terminate the employee.

I find it unacceptable that the death of a child is not included as a protected reason to qualify for 12 weeks of unpaid leave as part of the Family Medical Leave Act of 1993. Even people that have not lost a child can see the benefit in adding this to the already established Family Medical Leave Act.

Locally I have met with Congresswoman Judy Biggert and the issue has been featured on the front page of the Daily Herald (3/30/11). Nationally we have collected over 5,000 signatures and over 11,000 petition letters have sent to elected officials in Washington DC.

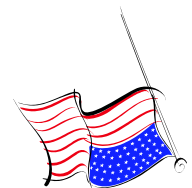
Sorrow Is Not Forever—Love Is —Michael A. Simpson, Birmingham, AL
