## How to Survive the Death of Your Child

- 1. Know that you are entitled to all of your feelings and emotions.
- 2. Know that there is no time table on your grieving process.
- 3. Be very gentle with yourself.
- 4. Know that it is scientifically proven that a loss of this magnitude is similar to a major physical injury.
- 5. Set healthy boundaries for yourself.
- 6. Find a support network.
- 7. Read books about grief.
- 8. Create a memorial for your child.
- 9. Wait at least one year before making any major decisions.
- 10. A counselor may help.
- 11. Prescribed Medication may help, however will not dissolve your pain.
- 12. Re-evaluate your relationships if they become hurtful.
- 13. Know that time is a huge factor.
- 14. Fight a good fight in honor of your child.
- 15. Try not to sweat the small stuff.
- 16. Know that you are not alone.
